### What is covered by this award:

Candidates must undertake 6 mandatory, 2 optional pathways and 3 optional Units

### Mandatory:

- Evaluate risk of abuse, failure to protect and harm to self and others
- Ensure personal safety and security
- Evaluate and develop own contribution to the service
- Develop interactions with clients
- Develop and sustain arrangements for joint working between workers and agencies
- Promote and maximise educational opportunities and achievements for individual children and young people

### Optional Pathways:

- Assist clients to decide on a course of action
- Assist clients to plan the implementation of a course of action

### What support will you get:

- The assessor will provide guidance on how to approach units and how to compile evidence to prove competence
- A learning programme of 12 training days will cover the knowledge and understanding required to meet the evidence requirements.
- Observation of your practice by a qualified assessor
- Your assessor will work with you giving you advice and tips to help you both develop your practice and to gain credit for the work you already do. Your programme will begin with your own personal training plan, which is geared to your individual needs. You will meet regularly with your assessor to plan and review work

**Course fees:** £2500.00 per person  
Costs include 12 training days and 52 hours assessor time

**Duration:** 12 – 18 months
